Damaged cable. Do not use a cable with brittle or defective insulation. Replace the cable.



Preparation

Prepare the HF unit.

- Prepare the HF unit.
 Refer to the HF unit's instruction manual.
- Connect the foot switch to the HF
 unit
- Connect a compatible HF cable to the HF unit.


Neutral electrode (patient return electrode),

(only for unipolar instruments).

- Attach a neutral electrode (patient return electrode) to the patient. Refer to the neutral electrode's and the HF unit's instruction manual.
- Connect the neutral electrode (patient return electrode) to the HF unit.







Prepare the endoscope.

- Prepare the endoscopic instrumentation.
 - Refer to the endoscope's instruction manual.
- Make sure that the HF cable is not yet connected to the endoscopic instrument at this point.



Insertion.

- Insert the endoscope.
- Perform any necessary distention or irrigation.
- · Adjust brightness.



Risk of injury.

Before connecting the HF-cable, make sure that the HF-unit has been switched off.

Make sure to connect the HF-cable to the instrument first, then to the HF-unit. Otherwise, there is a risk of injury.

Connect the HF-cable (not for A00010A, A00011A, A00012A).

- Connect the HF-cable to the instrument.
- Connect the HF-cable's other end to the HF-unit.
- · Switch on the HF-unit.
- Adjust the HF-unit's power output.

Connect the HF-cable (only for A00010A, A00011A, A00012A).

- Connect the HF-cable to the working element.
- Make sure that the rounded part of the white connecting plug fits into the rounded part of the receptacle. The connecting plug should click into
- Connect the other end of the HFcable to the HF-unit.
- · Switch on the HF-unit.
- · Adjust the HF-unit's power output.





Procedure.

- Activate HF current by pressing the foot switch.
- · Perform the procedure.

After Use

Disassemble the equipment.

- · Switch off the HF unit.
- · Disconnect the HF cable.

Reprocessing.

- Immediately bring the product to the reprocessing area.
- Reprocess the product following the instructions in this manual and in the Olympus Endoscopy System Guide.
